Genesis 2:18-3:20

The Word of God... is God's Word... for _____ family.

God's Word is to be taught _____ in our homes: when we ____ with our children... when we _____ with our children... when we go to ____ ... and when we _____ in the morning. We're to teach our families... to _____ the Lord our God with all our hearts... soul... and might trouble is... God's Word isn't being taught... not even in most Christian homes. That's why God's Word seems so foreign... even to Christian families.

Satan is telling everyone in America... that God's design is _____, _____, and it _____ work! Even Christian families are falling for it!

Aren't we supposed to be people of the Bible?
Aren't we supposed to be the people of God's Word?
Are we people living out God's design?

Look in **Genesis 2:18, 21, 22** - Adam was fully aware of his "_____" ... he was fully aware that he was "_____" - help": Adam knew that he was the only created being that wasn't "_____" God was fully aware of it as well: but Adam wasn't fully aware of what God was going to do about it.

Look at **Genesis 2:23** - When Adam first laid eyes on Eve... "Thank you... God! You did your best work on this one!"

Look at **Genesis 2:24** "Therefore... That tells me right there... that this just isn't about history. This has to do with the future! "In the _____ ... a man shall leave his father and mother... and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh."

When a man leaves, in the future, his father and mother...and takes to him a wife... _____ about his standing in the past... changes! Their marriage becomes a separate and accountable relationship. A husband now has his own marriage... and his own home.
